

Let's Talk Trash

- ♻️ Did you know that Anderson County spends nearly \$1 million of your taxpayer dollars on solid waste collection and disposal annually?
- ♻️ Did you know that Anderson County litter crews picked-up nearly 70,000 lbs of litter from our County roads in 2009 including 83,000 aluminum cans and 72,000 plastic drink bottles that are recyclable?
- ♻️ Did you know that Anderson County disposed of 63,000 tons of solid waste at the Chestnut Ridge Landfill in 2009?
- ♻️ Did you know that 60-70% of waste currently being disposed of in our landfills could be recycled?
- ♻️ Did you know that you can help Anderson County Government not only save money but also make money to off set the cost of disposing of solid waste?

BENEFITS OF RECYCLING

SAVES MONEY: Reducing the amount of waste going into the landfill saves the County (and you) money by reducing disposal costs. For example, a 10% reduction in waste would save over \$100,000 per year.

PROLONGS THE LIFE OF THE LANDFILL: Landfill costs continue to increase and landfill has limited space. Once the current landfill is closed significant increases in the cost of waste disposal will be incurred, as waste hauling and disposal costs will increase.

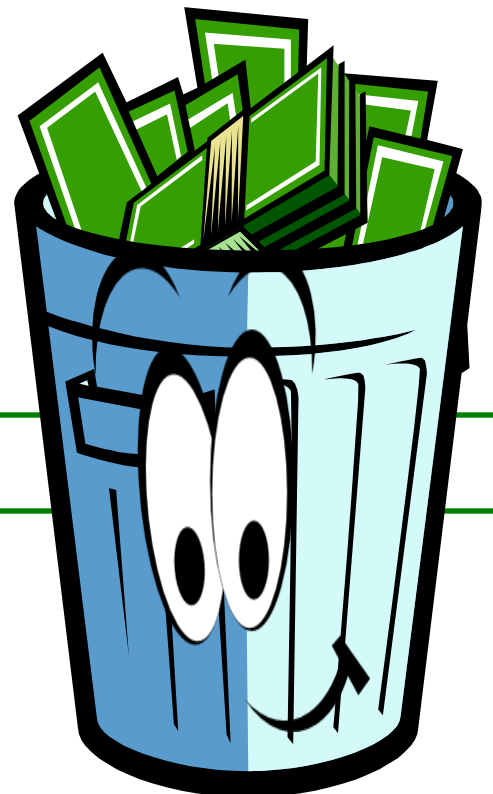
